I picked up my son's DMSA today. We were going to start chelation this month per the Cutler protocol. Now I hear about Oxidative Stress Relief. Time is of the essence, and I hate the thought of waiting until there is more data on the new stuff, but yet on the other hand, do not want to shortchange my son if there is a better chelator out there.
